## Town of Oakland Ordinance #K2007-001\*

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE AND OPERATONS OF SNOWMOBILES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF OAKLAND

Revised Ordinance No K2007-001\*

The Town Board of the Township of Oakland, Burnett County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows: SECTION 1. Whereas Chapter 350.04(2) of the 1967 Wisconsin Statutes gives the right to the Town of Oakland to designate certain streets and highways as snowmobile routes, the Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Burnett County, Wisconsin, does ordain that except as provided in Sections 350.02 and 305.03 of the Wisconsin Statutes, no person shall operate a snowmobile upon any public right of way of the Township of Oakland except as hereinafter designated. The following streets and highways are designated snowmobile routes:

- A.) From the northeast corner of SE SE Section 26 North on Johnson Lake Road approximately 500' (part of Trail 23);
- B.) Prospect Street to dead end;
- C.) Lone Pine Road to and including Entrance Road;
- D.) Jeffries Road to public access on Yellow Lake (Part of Trail 22).

SECTION 2. No person shall operate a snowmobile upon any of the above mentioned public highways or streets at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour.

SECTION 3. PENALTIES – Any person who shall violate any provision of the ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$50.00 for first offense, and not less than \$100.00 for second offense plus court costs.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

The above revised ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Oakland on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 2007.
